

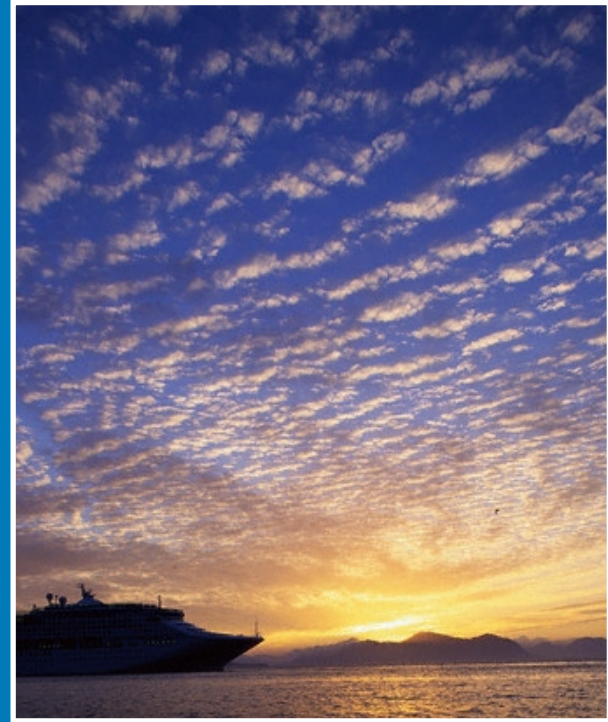

Shipping has vast opportunities, and the information you are about to receive is about a career in shipping on board ships.

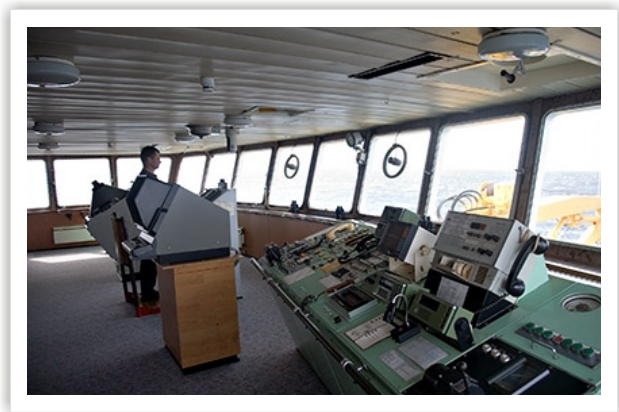

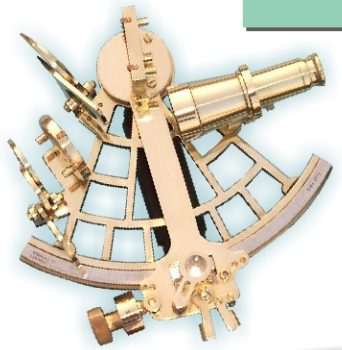
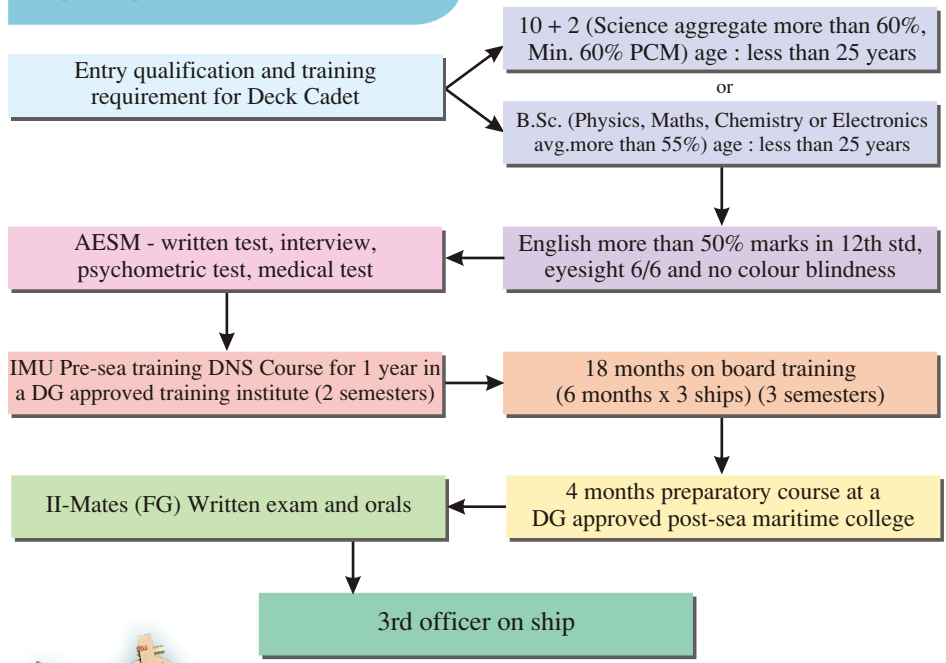
Career Path for Navigating Officers

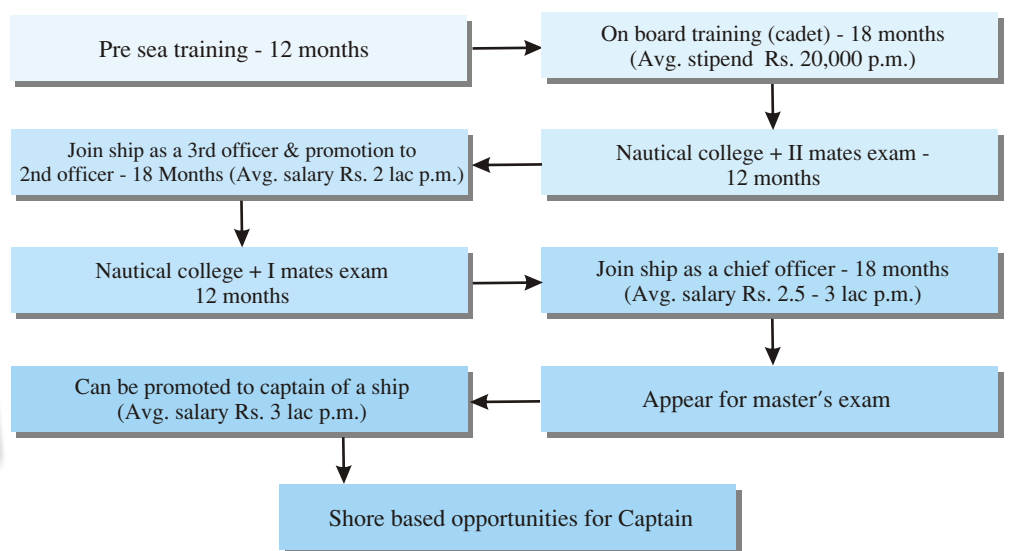

Career progression chart of Navigating Officer



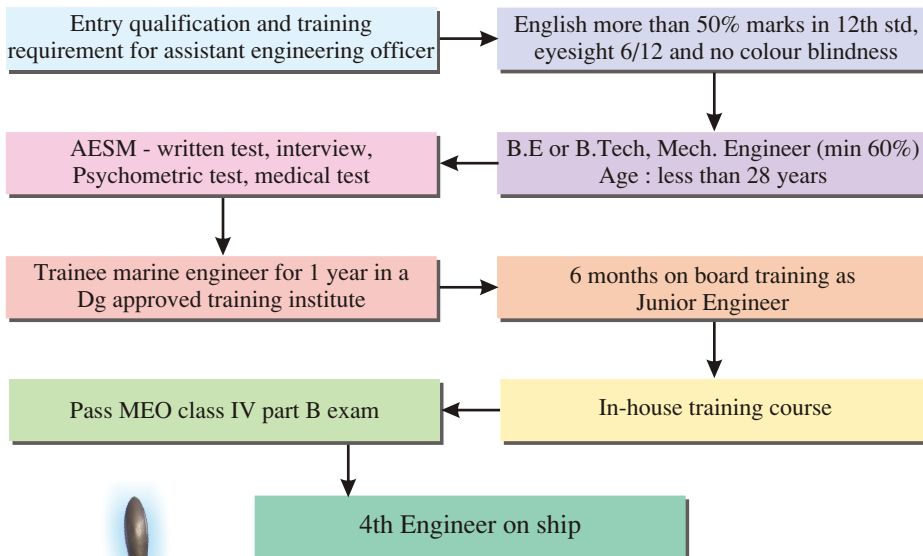
Career Path for Engineering Officers

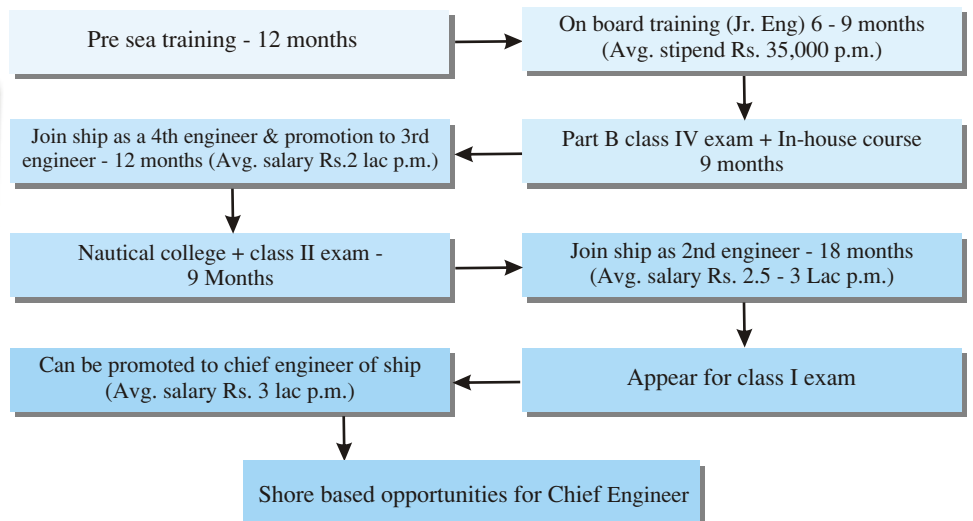
An Engineering Officer is the person responsible for ensuring that the machinery of the ship is maintained properly.
